4. Any amendment to the Grant Agreement may be signed on behalf of the grantee by the Official who, at the time of signing of the amendment, has the **TITLE** specified in paragraph 1 and the grantee will be bound by the amendment.

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-02**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING LOCAL PRETREATMENT DISCHARGE LIMITS FOR DISCHARGERS TO THE PENN TOWNSHIP WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY.**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township, York County, Pennsylvania, hereinafter referred to as the Township, adopted Ordinance No. 08-02 to allow business within the Township to hook up to and to discharge into the public sewer system established and maintained by Penn Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Penn Township, York County, Pennsylvania, enacted Ordinance No. 683 on February 18, 2009, setting pretreatment standards and providing enforcement procedures in conjunction with state and federal laws and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Township, in accordance with Penn Township, desires to establish specific Local Limits for pollutants of concern relating to discharges to the sewer system in accordance with Section 3.5 of Ordinance No. 683;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township that Maximum Allowable Industrial Loadings (MAIL) for the specified pollutants of concern, as approved by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), are hereby established as set forth below. These MAILs are developed to protect against pass through and interference, and to protect sludge quality. Individual limitations may be allocated to the Industrial Users as needed through Wastewater Discharge Permits issued to the Industrial Users in accordance with Section 4.3 of Ordinance No. 683.


