ORDINANCE 2025-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HEIDELBERG, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE A-85, AN ORDINANCE DECLARING WEEDS A NUISANCE, PROVIDING FOR THE CUTTING OF WEEDS, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES IN VIOLATION OF ITS PROVISIONS

WHEREAS, on October 2, 1985, the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township, York County, Pennsylvania, enacted Ordinance No. A-85, An Ordinance Declaring Weeds a Nuisance; Providing for the Cutting of Weeds; and Prescribing Penalties in Violation of its Provisions: and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors wishes to amend Section III of Ordinance No. A-85, relating to providing Notice to Owners and Occupants of Premises.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township, York County, & Street Pennsylvania, enacts and ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: Section III of Ordinance No. A-85, Notice of Owners and Occupants of Premises, is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

Section III

Notice to Owners and Occupants of Premises

Any officer or employee of the Township designated thereby for the purpose, is hereby authorized to give notice by personal service, by United States Certified Mail Return Receipt Requested, or by United States First Class Mail, addressed to the owner or the occupant, or either of them, at the last known address, of a violation of the terms and conditions of this Ordinance, directing and requiring such occupant or owner or both of them, to remove, trim, spray, or cut such grass, weeds or vegetation, so as to conform to the requirements of this Ordinance, within five (5) days after issuance of such Notice. In the event that the mailed notice is returned as undelivered or unclaimed, notice may be given by posting notice in a conspicuous place at the subject property.

SECTION 2: Repealer. Any provisions of previous Ordinances of the Township which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are expressly repealed to the extent of any inconsistency.

SECTION 3: Savings Clause. In all other respects, the Ordinances of the Township shall remain as previously enacted and ordained.

SECTION 4: Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if any of its sections, clauses, or sentences shall be held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional, such provision

shall not affect or impair any remaining sections, clauses, or sentences of the same.

SECTION 6: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with law.
