**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
HEIDELBERG TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE AGRICULTURAL SECURITY
AREA ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND ESTABLISHING STAGGERED
TERMS OF OFFICE**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township (“Board”) has, by resolution duly adopted, established an Agricultural Security Area Advisory Committee (“Committee”) pursuant to its authority and consistent with the Pennsylvania Agricultural Area Security Law, 3 P.S. § 901, *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to appoint members of the Committee to promote continuity and orderly administration.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ADOPTED by the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township, York County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. Appointments

Section 3. Service

Members shall serve at the pleasure of the Township Board of Supervisors, who shall fill vacancies as they arise from time to time. Members shall serve without salary, but the Board of Supervisors may entitle each such member to reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of official duties.

Section 5. Effective Date

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

Section 8. Repealer

All resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 9. Severability

The provisions of this Resolution are severable. If any provision is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions.
