Redundancy: What is needed if current system fails

New well – no suitable location on current property

Storage: to bridge the gap if failure occurs

15k gallon tank and two booster pumps

Consistent pressure

Three days' supply (per DEP recommendation)

Tank material considered: poly/FRP, steel, concrete

Considerations: lining, reinforcement, longevity

Tank could be replenished with tanker trucks of potable water

Anthony estimated line replacement, ground tank, and booster pumps at \$400k-\$500k

Other:

Replacing lines

Source to tank(s)

Tanks to curb stops

Curb stops to home (township or homeowner?)

Lining existing lines

Follow-up discussion

What are amortized costs of options

Current property and planned fence would be sufficient for tank

What is/was the original DEP recommendations/requirements?

What are most likely problems with existing well? Electrical, lines, depletion, etc

Next steps:

CS Davidson to finalize this study for approval by 06/30/2026

CS Davidson to start next grant process: generator, fencing, lighting
