

ORDINANCE 2026-06

AN ORDINANCE OF HEIDELBERG TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 88-2, AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT ON PORTERS ROAD

WHEREAS, Heidelberg Township, York County, Pennsylvania is a township of the second class, organized and existing pursuant to Pennsylvania's Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. § 65101, *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, on September 7, 1988, the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township, York County, Pennsylvania, enacted Ordinance No. 88-2, An Ordinance Establishing Maximum Speed Limits on Certain Streets; and

WHEREAS, on January 4, 1999, the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township, York County, Pennsylvania, enacted an un-numbered Ordinance establishing Maximum Speed Limits on Certain Streets, supplementing Ordinance No. 88-2 by adding additional streets; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors wish to amend Ordinance No. 88-2, as amended and supplemented, to update maximum permitted speed limits on certain roads as indicated below; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township, York County, Pennsylvania, enacts and ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: Recitals. The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference.

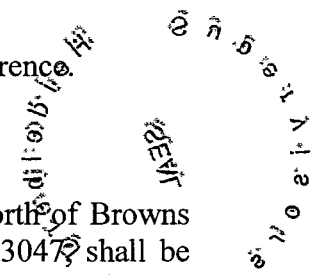
SECTION 2: Enactment.

A. The maximum permitted speed on Porters Road, one half mile north of Browns Road to Thoman Road, in accordance with PennDOT Speed Limit Permit 8-4-3047~~8~~ shall be lowered from thirty-five miles per hour (35 mph) to twenty-five miles per hour (25 mph). The remaining length of Porters Road shall retain a maximum permitted speed of thirty-five miles per hour (35 mph). Ordinance 88-2 shall be amended accordingly.

B. The speed limits set forth and established in Section 2 hereof have been determined in accordance with 75 Pa.C.S.A. §§ 3363 and 6109(10).

C. The Township Roadmaster is hereby directed to post the maximum speed limits as set forth above in accordance with the posting requirements of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code.

SECTION 3: Repealer. The provisions of Ordinance No. 88-2, as amended and supplemented, which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are expressly repealed to the extent of any inconsistency.




SECTION 4: Savings Clause. In all other respects, Ordinance No. 88-2, as amended and supplemented, shall remain as enacted and ordained.

SECTION 5: Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if any of its sections, clauses, or sentences shall be held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional, such provision shall not affect or impair any remaining sections, clauses, or sentences of the same.

SECTION 6: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with law.
